

NOTICE of RACE CHS 2010
32nd AUSTRALIAN SECONDARY SCHOOLS SAILING CHAMPIONSHIP
and the
35th ANNUAL NSW SECONDARY SCHOOLS SAILING CHAMPIONSHIPS
in conjunction with
THE 44th ANNUAL COMBINED HIGH SCHOOLS SAILING CHAMPIONSHIPS
6th April to 10th April 2010

1.0 ORGANISING AUTHORITY : Belmont 16' Sailing Club (in association with CHS Sailing Committee)

2.0 REGISTRATION: Tue - 6th Apr 9.00hrs to 12.00hrs.

3.0 SAILING SCHEDULE, FORMAT, COURSES & SCORING:

An invitation race is scheduled for Tuesday 6th April with 4 heats over the remaining 4 days at the discretion of the race committee.

The starting signal for the race for each day will not be before 13.00hrs

On the last scheduled day of the event the start signal will not be before 12.00hrs and no race shall be started after 15.00hrs and presentation will be held at 18.30hrs. A briefing will be held at 10.45hrs on the morning of each scheduled day of racing. Course configuration will be available in the Sailing Instructions but may be subject to change. The races are sailed on the same course in five divisions.

DIV 1 Larger Monohulls

DIV 111 Catamarans

DIV 11 Smaller Monohulls

DIV 1V Sailboards

DIV V Sailability

Places for 1st, 2nd and 3rd are awarded in each division and in classes within divisions in the three Championships. The Low Point scoring system will apply (RRS Appendix A) and a Correction Factor (TCF) shall be given to each class competing. One discard is allowed.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY:

(a) Skipper and crew **MUST** be students attending an Australian Secondary School.

(b) Boats of any class registered with class association and their State or National authority (e.g. YNSW) may enter.

(c) **All entrants must be insured with \$10 million 3rd party liability cover.**

5.0 ACCOMMODATION:

Camping and caravanning facilities are available in close proximity to the Sailing Club for more information

6.0 ENTRY TO THE AUSTRALIAN SECONDARY SCHOOLS SAILING CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The closing date is the 19th March. All late entries will be subject to late entry fee of \$15 per student.
